### **FUTURE HIGH STREETS FUND - QUEEN STREET, NEWTON ABBOT**

At the Council's Extraordinary Meeting held on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2024 Newton Abbot Town Council passed, by a large majority, the following Resolution:-

'that Newton Abbot Town Council makes very strong representations to the County and District Councils for the scheme to be abandoned in the light of the many concerns expressed by businesses and users of Queen Street.'

The Town Council has considered at length the representations it has received from businesses, residents and users of Queen Street, Newton Abbot and as a result of the overwhelming concerns expressed in those representations came to the conclusion set out above. The Council as you will be aware formally objected to two out of the three Traffic Regulation Orders proposed for Queen Street, Devon Square and St Paul's Road but those objections were ignored. Additionally, the public consultation on those same TRO's resulted in an overwhelming majority against them. Again, that was ignored.

Therefore, arising from the above, I write to you on the Town Council's behalf to request in the strongest possible terms that the joint proposals by your Council with Devon County/Teignbridge District Council be abandoned.
